Academic-based scholarships -**Opens on January 01, 2019 and closes on May 31, 2019**

C. Who can apply for Financial Aid for the Student?

The parent (s) or legal guardian claiming the student on their income taxes

D. What kind of documents do I need?

2017 1040 forms (Income taxes) W2s 2018, any public assistance statements, social security benefits (Retirement or Disability statements) or any other document proving income.

E. What is the requirement GPA for Financial Aid?

The required GPA for Financial Aid is 2.00

F. When will I find out if I was awarded Financial Aid?

Catholic Education Foundation (CEF) will notify you in March 2019
Junipero Serra's Financial Aid (FACTS)- Once your Financial Aid is complete and you have received an acceptance notice from the Admission Department a financial aid offer will be made and awarded once the student is registered at Junipero Serra High School.
Academic-based scholarships-By June 30, 2019

G. Do I need to complete the Admission Process before Financial Aid?

Yes, you must complete the Admission Process in order for your financial aid application to be evaluated and considered for aid.

H. How does the Scholarship Process work?

Scholarships are based on GPA, school participation and citizenship. The student may apply for the academic scholarship by submitting a 300 word essay by the deadline. (Please refer to the scholarship handouts)

I. What is the required GPA for the Scholarship?

Student must have a 3.0 GPA or higher

J. Are the academic scholarships financial base need?

No, Academic Scholarships are base on GPA, school participation and citizenship. Financial and non-financial aid student may enter the competition.
