

Calculus CLEP

Course Description: Calculus CLEP is a college level mathematics course. The topics for Calculus CLEP are divided into three major themes: 1) functions, graphs, and limits 2) derivatives, and 3) integrals.

The Calculus CLEP examination covers skills and concepts that are usually taught in a one-semester college course in calculus. The content of each examination is approximately 60% limits and differential calculus and 40% integral calculus. Algebraic, trigonometric, exponential, logarithmic and general functions are included. The exam is primarily concerned with an intuitive understanding of calculus and experience with its methods and applications. Knowledge of preparatory mathematics, including algebra, geometry, trigonometry and analytic geometry is assumed.
