PRACTICE SHEET-NOT TO BE SUBMITTED

A. You must staple last semester's report card (or a photocopy) to this application form.

B. To qualify for CSF membership this semester, follow these guidelines:

1. You must earn a *minimum of 10 points* from last semester's grades.

- a) The first *4 points* must be from LIST I (Consult the LISTS on the reverse side.)
- b) The first *7 points* (including the four points described in a) must be from LISTS I and II.
- c) The remaining points may come from any LIST (I, II or III).

2. You must use NO MORE THAN FIVE COURSES to qualify.

3. No CSF points are given for Summer School courses, physical education, courses taken in lieu of physical education, subjects repeated to improve a grade, courses involving clerking and office/teaching assisting, courses taken on a pass/fail basis.

4. CSF points are granted as follows:

- a grade of A = 3 CSF points
- a grade of B = 1 CSF point
- One additional point shall be granted for a grade of A or B in an AP, IB, or Honors course, UP TO A MAXIMUM OF TWO SUCH POINTS PER SEMESTER.
- a grade of C = 0 CSF points
- a grade of D or F in any course, even in one you cannot use to qualify, disqualifies you from membership at this time.

C. Also remember:

- 1. Semester membership is based on work done in the *previous semester*.
- 2. You must reapply *each* semester.
- 3. Courses you may use are listed on the reverse side. They are divided into LISTS I, II, and III.
