FINANCIAL AID

Financial Aid is available to well-qualified students who are not able to meet the cost of their college education. This aid may be in the form of loans from colleges, government, various private organizations, scholarships, or work-study programs.

Students should not prejudge their eligibility but should apply for aid from as many different sources as possible. They should find out exactly what they have to do to apply for aid at the college of their choice. Acting promptly and applying properly are the best ways to improve chances of receiving aid.

In addition to support from the family, most colleges expect students to meet part of their cost through summer employment and earnings.
