V. **Public Comment/Input:** Public Input on staff shirts: Ron Carroll suggested we consider purchasing a "Growth Mindset" with the fact that it supports our school goal of support for college and career. Paula Mayes suggested that ASB or WEB use it as a fundraiser with students as well so they can wear them on College Wednesday or Spirit Day Fridays. Mrs. KJ asked if SSC would pay for conferences. Dr. Salehi shared that SSC has approved money for teachers to attend conferences and instructional release days. We can look at another source of money to get substitutes for student activities.

VII. **New Business: Legal Requirements:**

- a. The 2018-2019 Preliminary Title I Allocation including the Carryover amount is \$296,252. We had \$10,107 left from 2017-18 and it is included in the prior amount.
- b. EL Program Evaluation: Dr. Salehi shared the ELPAC results with the team and explained that overall students have to receive a 4 with a 3 in each subset of domains. Students must also meet expectations of either iReady or SBAC based on district reclassification criteria. Students can also satisfy this requirement with the PSAT scores in 8<sup>th</sup> grade. Dr. Salehi reviewed the data of our current ELs. Lisa House asked whether students who are in special education also get accommodations. Dr. Salehi shared that they receive accommodations but not modification. All students who are EL get additional support with AVID Excel, ELD, or Dual Immersion.
- c. Review and approve the parent involvement policy: Dr. Salehi shared that over 300 parents attended the Title I meeting at Back to School Night. At Coffee with the Counselors and ELAC we ask for parents to advise our Title 1 plans. Last year and this year we have parent support classes to help our parents and work together to support student progress. We meet twice a year with EL parents to help monitor the progress of EL students. Our counselors and intervention teachers meet with parents, teachers, and students in ongoing continued supports throughout the year. All teachers at our site are credentialed for the classes they teach. The Parent Involvement Policy was shared at Back to School Night and advice was taken to improve the policy. - d. Discuss ELAC advices: Dr. Salehi shared that many ELAC parents attend Coffee with the Counselors and have advised our school as to next meetings and workshops. The next ELAC meeting will be tomorrow. We are having a Coffee with the Counselors tonight at 6pm based on parent feedback. Lisa House asked

if there was anything teachers need to know in regards to what is shared at the parent meetings. Dr. Salehi shared that today's presentation was in regards to CCGI, how to sign up for parent conferences workshop.

- a. ELAC/DELAC: Silvia shared that tomorrow there is a ELAC meeting at 8:45am. They are going to share information on how ELs are reclassified. On Tuesday, Youth Healthline will share out information on common drugs and issues in regards to drug education. She shared that John Glenn High School's College and Career Day is next Tuesday.
- b. AVID: Mrs. House stated that they are continuing to collaborate and starting their TRFs (Tutorial Request Forms). Dr. Salehi shared we hired 3 new tutors and they will start when their fingerprints get approved.
- c. Magnet: Mrs. KJ shared that they have robots for 80 students and Mrs. Snyder has met with district PLTW TOSA to support a VEX team for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade.
