Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Pennsylvania System of School Assessment Tests will be administered at West Shamokin Jr.-Sr. High School beginning the week of April 22, 2019. Students in Grade 7 will take tests in English Language Arts and Math, while students in Grade 8 will be assessed in English Language Arts, Math and Science. The tentative schedules for the exams to be administered are during the following dates:

ELA	April 23, 24, 25
Math	April 29, 30
Science	May 1

Parents/Guardians of students participating in the PA Assessments may review the assessments by making arrangements in advance with the school office. No copies of the assessments will be permitted to leave the area where reviews will occur, nor will note-taking and/or photocopying be permitted. Appointments to review the material or any questions concerning the test may be made through my office at the number listed above.

Section 4.4 of Chapter 4 provides for the right of parents (or guardians) to excuse their children from the state assessment if, **upon inspection of the testing materials**, they find the assessment to be in conflict with their religious beliefs. **This is the only basis for a parental excusal from the statewide assessments.** After reviewing the test(s) parents/guardians must provide a written request addressed to the superintendent for excusal based upon religious conflict.

As a reminder: Students are not permitted to have cell phones, cameras, or any other electronic devices in their possession during the administration of the assessments. Students will need to be aware of the attached district policy in advance and encouraged to leave such items at home on assessment days.

Student attendance and participation in the PA Assessment Program is representative of the school's academic performance. Your attention to this very important academic matter is appreciated. Please do not hesitate to contact me at the number listed above if you have any questions.
