MHS Parent/Guardians and Students,

As we look ahead to *Homecoming Week* at Montour High School, individuals attending the *MHS Homecoming Interlude* are reminded that the health, safety, and welfare of all of our students is our primary focus and concern.

Students attending the *MHS Homecoming Interlude*, on Saturday, September 14<sup>th</sup>, are advised of the following procedures for entering this year's venue, *The Marriott City Center*...

- Any containers that can hold liquid are prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to water bottles, pop bottles and cans, flasks, hairspray containers, etc...
- Students will enter in two separate lines (male and female).
- Students will be greeted by MHS Administration.
- Female students entering with a purse/handbag will be required to open their purse/handbag for a visual inspection conducted by Local Law Enforcement and Montour School District Security.
- Male students will be required to open their outer jacket for a visual inspection conducted by Local Law Enforcement and Montour School District Security.
- All students will be scanned by a hand-held metal detector. Female students will be scanned by a female Montour School District Security Officer. Male students will be scanned by a male Montour School District Security Officer.

**In addition to the above...**

- The wearing of sunglasses is prohibited.
- After entering the venue students will not be permitted to leave the venue until the official event end time.
- Smoking/vaping inside and/or outside of the venue is strictly prohibited. The possession of tobacco/vaping products is strictly prohibited. Students in possession of and/or using tobacco/vaping products will be referred to Local Law Enforcement and will be processed accordingly.
- The possession and/or consumption of drugs and/or alcohol prior to or during the event are strictly prohibited. Students in possession of and/or who have consumed drugs and/or alcohol before and/or during the event will be referred to the Local Law Enforcement and will be processed accordingly.
- Any student, who is believed to be under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol, will immediately be referred to Local Law Enforcement and will be processed accordingly.
- Inappropriate and sexually explicit dancing that includes grinding and back to front dancing is strictly prohibited. Students who engage in inappropriate dancing will be immediately removed from the event and immediately sent home. No warnings will be given. Students, who do not want to engage in appropriate dancing, should not attend the event.
- All students attending the *MHS Homecoming Interlude* are subject to all Montour School District Policies and all rules and regulations as outlined in the Montour High School Student/Parent Handbook.

It is expected that all students attending the *MHS Homecoming Interlude* abide by all of the above. MHS Administration will not tolerate behavior that is not conducive to a healthy and safe school-sponsored event.
