RE-APPLY FOR FREE/REDUCED LUNCH BY THE END OF SEPTEMBER All returning students who received a free or reduced-priced meal last year, are strongly encouraged to re-apply by the end of September, to ensure no interruption in free or reduced priced meals. KINDERGARTEN FAMILIES Present kindergartners need to have the "<u>Physical Exam form</u>" (this is not the immunization record) and the "<u>Oral Health form</u>" completed by their doctor/dentist, and on file in the school office, before the start of first grade. If you have not already taken care of this, please do so. These forms are on the Cornell Website under Parents, then <u>Commonly Used Forms</u>. VOLUNTEERING AT CORNELL SCHOOL DMV driver's reports are good for one year from date of issuance. To request by mail, <u>INF 1125 form</u> (copies are available in the office as well). Check off the box for "DriverLicense/ID Record". Mail the form along with a check for \$5 to the DMV as noted on the form. Allow 6-8 weeks to arrive. **A reminder that the district requires an** *official* **copy of your Drivers Record and the online version you can print out is <u>not</u> considered an official document.**

NEVER VOLUNTEERED/CHAPERONED OR DRIVEN ON A FIELD TRIP? If you would like to volunteer in your child's classroom or drive for field trips, please be sure to get your TB clearance and fingerprints now. The volunteer approval process does take several weeks, so please have all your paperwork into the school office in plenty of time. TB tests need to be renewed every 4 years, while Livescan fingerprinting only needs to be completed once. Please complete the Volunteer II application found on the district website at <u>AUSD volunteer website</u>. The TB test is required before fingerprinting.
