- ❖ Have the ability to direct and supervise all of his football staff.
- ❖ Be able to work directly along with the Booster Club program.
- ❖ Manage and supervise athletic activities, contests, and practice sessions to promote individual growth in athletic skills, teamwork, discipline, respect, and good sportsmanship.
- ❖ Work with other staff to plan and put in place goals and objectives to ensure the overall development of athletes.
- ❖ Ensures that all football coaches work together toward a common goal within the football program and the Athletic Director.
