Dear Aiea High Parents and Guardians:

We are sending this letter home to inform you of a Stranger Danger incident that was reported near the Aiea Public Library on Pohai Place. At approximately 10:30 a.m. this morning, a group of students reported being approached by an adult male who offered them drugs. The students refused and reported the incident to school officials. A police report was filed and this incident is under investigation.

The safety of your children is of utmost importance. We are sending this letter to you as a precaution and to encourage you to continue to speak to your child regarding measures to stay safe, specifically about "stranger danger." As an added precaution, please reinforce the following "stranger danger" safety measures with your child:

- Stay away from strangers, do not talk to or take anything from them.
- Don't go anywhere with someone you don't know. Never accept a ride from a stranger.
- Stay more than an arm's reach away from strangers. If a stranger approaches you, seek help immediately from a trusted adult.
- Use the buddy system; avoid walking anywhere alone.
- If a stranger grabs you, do whatever it takes to stop the stranger, yell for help.
- Report any suspicious activity to a trusted adult.
- Be alert of your surroundings and let others know where you will be and what time you will return.
