Evans Comprehensive High School is a public suburban high school that serves a diverse population of approximately 1,830 students. Our mission is to facilitate and enrich learning by preparing individuals to succeed as productive community members who can compete in the work place and fulfill goals for higher education. Evans focuses on improving student instruction by motivating students to learn, improving thinking and reasoning capabilities, and applying knowledge and reasoning with technology. Evans takes pride in the dedication of its faculty, staff, and students and in the ongoing support of parents and community members. ## Faculty Profile

The EHS faculty and staff are comprised of 103 certified faculty members, 5 administrators, 1 media specialist, 1 instructional technology specialist 8 paraprofessionals, 7 support staff personnel, 4 ½ guidance counselors, one graduation coach, one public safety officer, one technology support specialist, 13 nutrition workers and 8 custodians. 76% of our faculty members have a master's or specialist's degree. 97% of the EHS faculty have 5 or more years teaching experience and 36% have 20 or more years.

Evans demographics consist of 61% Caucasian, 21% African-American, 9% Hispanic, 6% two or more races, and 3% Asian. Free or reduced lunch is served to 34% of the students.

## Facilities

The school opened in the fall of 1926 and relocated in 1980 to the current campus on 4550 Cox Road. Evans High School provides a diverse curriculum, including specialized vocational, athletic, special education, gifted, STEM, and advanced placement programs. The campus consists of 53 standard classrooms, 13 science labs, 7 portable classrooms, learning commons with access to computers and digital resources, 5 mobile computer labs and 4 computer labs, auditorium, choral room, art studio with a kiln, and a large band room. CTAE classes have access to Agriculture, Automotive, Broadcasting, Business, Clinicals, Construction, Culinary, Engineering, Graphics and Metal Working labs. The agriculture class also utilizes two on-site greenhouses and outdoor garden facilities. Athletic facilities include a gymnasium, football stadium with a running track, football practice field, weight room, softball field, baseball field, tennis courts, and a beach volleyball court. Wireless Internet provides students the opportunity to bring their own technological devices (BYOT) to utilize in class activities.
