- B. A student hand-written essay is required in the form of a cover letter. (Details below.)
- C. Because the intimacy of a small school environment better promotes education, our total enrollment is limited, not to exceed 27:1 ADA (average daily attendance).
- D. Our student body encompasses grades 6-8.

In addition to the admission policies given above, applicant preference for Quail Hollow Integrated Arts shall be given in the following order:

1. To current students in Quail Hollow Integrated Arts
2. Children of SLVUSD Charter School Staff
3. Siblings of current Quail Hollow Integrated Arts students
4. Students who live inside and outside of the school district, based on the date of thoroughly completed application forms

**For new students applying to the Quail Hollow Integrated Arts in grades 6-8 this application must include: A cover letter\*, in ink, in applicant's handwriting, addressing the following:**

- Applicant's desire to attend the QHIA program; please state reasons why a Visual and Performing Arts (VAPA) Integrated educational program appeals to you.
- Applicant's experience, if any, in one or more to the primary VAPA disciplines: Visual Arts, Theater, Dance and Music
- Academic interests, strengths, and challenges
- Hobbies and interests other than VAPA
