- VII. New Business: Legal Requirements:**
 - a. Review School Plan and budget 2019-2020 Title I Allocation According to ConApp for Los Alisos Middle School which Includes the Parent Involvement Centralized Services. Dr. Salehi shared that the budget is similar to last year. We may see a slight increase when we get our final allocation. The SPSA includes goals for ELA, Math, English Learners, Parent Involvement, School Climate & Attendance, and College and Career Readiness. Once we get the SBAC and ELPAC results we will update the goals based on the 2018-19 data. All goals are aligned with the NLMUSD LCAP goals and initiatives. Our enrollment has decreased by approximately 90 students and we are losing 1 teacher. We are keeping our Intervention Counselor and Intervention Teacher.
 - b. Review and discuss ELAC advices: ELAC is pleased with AVID Excel Summer Bridge, After School Tutoring, ELPAC Boot-Camp, and parent involvement programs. In addition, ELAC advised a summer bridge class for incoming ELL 6th grade students this year. We are also planning to provide students who need support with social-emotional learning an 8-day program before school starts.
 - c. Approve the SPSA and budget for 2019-2020 School Year Moved: Ron Approved: Enrique The 2019-2020 Title I Allocation According to ConApp for Los Alisos Middle School Which Includes the Parent Involvement Centralized Services is \$334,876.
 - d. SSC Selection Process for next year: 2019-20: Enrique Gonzales will serve his 2nd year We will have 3 openings for teachers, 3 openings for students, and 2 openings for parents. Election of new members will take place in August 2019.

 - a. ELAC/DELAC- ELAC had their final meeting of the year in May. Parents reviewed and discussed the EL programs and services and provided feedback and advice for SSC. ELAC is pleased with AVID Excel

- b. AVID- We are filling classes for next year's Master Schedule. We are still looking for some 8th grade students.
- c. Magnet- We are offering Medical Detectives and Green Architecture in 6th grade in Magnet next year. These courses align better with NGSS Standards for 6th grade. We have 4 courses in 6th grade, 5 courses in 7th grade, and 7 courses in 8th grade.
