

## **STUDENT POLICIES GOALS**

It shall be the intent of the Seaford Board of Education to maintain student-related policies which are consistent with the governing values, philosophy, and mission of the Seaford School District. More specifically, the Board will maintain policies which support the beliefs that:

1. all students can learn;
2. students have the right to exercise the ability to think;
3. integrity is critical to the school, home, and community;
4. every student has dignity and is to be treated with respect;
5. human diversity is a strength upon which we can build;
6. responsible student behavior is essential to learning; and
7. parent and community involvement is critical to student success.

Furthermore, the Board will maintain policies which:

1. attend to matters of student health and safety;
2. promote an environment conducive to student learning and achievement so as to help each student realize his/her fullest potential;
3. uphold the rights of students as citizens;
4. encourage active and constructive student involvement in the education program, including co-curricular and extracurricular activities; and
5. provide a well-defined and constructive avenue for student communications and/or complaints.
