OUR STUDENTS

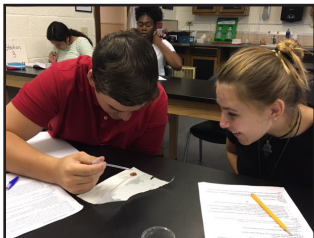
- Enrollment of 327 students from PS3 –12th grade
