Near and color vision and depth perception. Use of both eyes with corrective lenses. Sense of smell, speaking, normal hearing and able to distinguish sounds in transmission.

Mental:

Stress of deadlines and normal work standards stress. Ability to work with interruption. Concentrate for long periods of time. Reading. Interpreting policy. Calculate, perform routine math process. Memorize and recall objects, people. Analyze problems and generate altern.

Working Conditions:

Work above ground level (ladders). Irregular hours.
