PAY FOR SCHOOL MEALS ONLINE

There is now a new way to make payments for your child's meals. You now can check your child's school meal account balance online, as well as make payments with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express credit or debit card. Go online to www.EZSchoolPay.com, create an online account with your child's last name and student number, which is located under his/her name on their report card. The website will guide you to create an account and link your student(s) to the account before entering a credit/payment. You will not have to wonder if the check you wrote for meals actually made it to school, and your children will be assured that meals will continue uninterrupted.

Features and Options:

- Send payments faster and directly into your child's meal accounts: Payments are credited within 10 minutes.
- Mobile applications: EZSchoolPay is available from your device's app store and is available for iPhone, iPad, and Android devices. Receive alerts of low balances, make payments for your child's meal account, and purchase items from the school store.
- Low Balances: Receive alerts when your child's balance drops below a certain balance.

SY 2018-2019 UNIFORM ONLINE ORDERING - NOW OPEN

School uniform t-shirts are required to be worn Monday through Friday. These are the uniform options that are available from Kula Threads. 7th GRADE REQUIREMENT - PHYSICAL EXAM

All students entering 7th grade for school year 2018-2019 need to have a physical exam. The physical should be done within the 12-month period before the start of 7th grade. Families should plan ahead and schedule appointments early to ensure the exam is completed in a timely manner. In April, Form 14 was given to all 6th graders along with a letter from the DOE and DOH. Bring the form to your child's exam to be completed during the visit. Submit the completed Form 14 to the Health Aide before school starts.
