

Guidelines for summer WCC courses for Wilkes County Schools students enrolled in WCS on June 3, 2019:

- Students have 5 days after the first day of class to drop a course. No grade will be reported if a course is dropped within this time frame.
- If students choose to drop a course, the student **MUST** contact Jon Hutchins that they wish to drop the course. He will take care of the drop on the WCC end.
- If a course is dropped after the 5 day period, they will receive a grade for the course.
- All grades earned in summer coursework at WCC will be on the high school transcript. Students do not have the option for the course to not be on the transcript.
- For Online Courses: students must complete the enrollment verification on the first day of an online course or they will be automatically dropped from the course.
