February - April 1st

April 1st - 31st

Access and review your financial award letter

May 1st

Submit SIR along with deposit and housing application

Official SAT Scores

After submitting your CSU/UC applications, log into CollegeBoard or ACT Student and officially send your scores. Adding your scores on your application informs colleges you have taken the exam but do not serve as official scores.

How to send your scores?

Log into CollegeBoard, click on My SAT and find the Send Scores icon. To send to UC's, **only add one UC**. If sending to Cal States, add CSU Apply or **3594** on other search options.

Viewing your Cal Grant

1. Visit www.webgrants4students.org and Click on Create Account using your Social Security Number or Dream ID number.
2. Once logged in, you can select view Cal Grant award.
3. Once you decide which school to attend next Fall, you can select 'Make School change.'
