As we embark on these unusual times, all of our Kermit ISD campuses are closed however we have been working with our essential personnel to come up with a plan for providing instruction as we move forward. With that being said these plans will be unique and tailored to the needs of our KISD students. Our new mode of instruction will begin on Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup>. Please see below the individual plans for each campus and student instruction moving forward.

Kermit Elementary:

- Each grade level will provide a weekly instructional review packet. Packets for 1<sup>st</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> grade will be available during the time you stop by KES to pick up your breakfast/lunch combo meal provided by KISD. Please be prepared to provide us with the grade level packets you will need.
- If you do not plan to pick up meals, your students weekly instructional packets will be available through the front foyer at KES between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.
- PK-Kinder students can pick up individual student packets in the KES front foyer.
- We will also be providing a 30-minute Zoom (online) sessions twice a week to provide time for student teacher interaction. (Instructions to access the Zoom online platform will be provided with your 1<sup>st</sup> instructional packet).
- You may drop off your completed packets and library books in the front foyer.

Kermit Junior High/High School:

- All core classes will be providing students with 3 review lessons a week via Google classroom created by their core teachers (English, Math, Science, Social Studies classes).
- We will also be providing a 30-minute Zoom (online) sessions twice a week to provide time for student teacher interaction. Instructions on how to access Zoom will be provided via Google classroom and campus social media sites.
- If you do not have access to one of the following: Laptop, tablet/iPad, cell phone, gaming console, SMART TV, desktop computer and internet access. Please contact the main office of your student's campus. KJH 432-586-1040. KHS 432-586-1050.
