The bus loop at Coldspring Intermediate is nearly completed, with the awning soon to be installed. The Pre-K wing building is up and crews are working on the interior installations.

Lincoln Junior High's Student Drop-Off area is already in use, and the foundations have been laid and beams and roofs installed on the new science wing, band hall, and locker room additions to the gym.

Construction fences are up at the high school and dirt work has begun. The COCISD Board of Trustees will hold a groundbreaking ceremony on Tuesday, Jan. 22, at 5 p.m.
