### AUSD Uniform Policy Grades K-8

District-wide mandatory uniforms are to be worn daily. Pants/Shorts/ Skirts/Skorts/ Jumpers:

- Color: Navy blue, khaki
  - Style: Fitted at the waist or elastic waist
  - Fabric: Twill, cotton or cotton blend, polyester blend, corduroy; sweat materials are not acceptable. Skirts/Skorts/Jumper length must be mid-thigh (bottom of fingertips) to mid-calf
- Shirts/Blouses:

- Color: Navy blue, white or school color
- Style: Polo, turtleneck, short or long sleeves
- Note: All shirts and blouses must have collars and sleeves.
