# CCS ATHLETIC CONTRACT

The CCS athletic program is designed for students who are capable of and desire a higher level of competition than provided in the core physical education program. Participation on an athletic team is a PRIVILEGE for those students who have the motivation and skills to work at a higher level of intensity and productiveness.

Each student will have an equal opportunity to try out for an athletic team. Trying out for a team is an experience that allows all students an equal chance to achieve membership on a team, while allowing the coaching staff to evaluate the skills, work ethics and coachability of each student athlete. Through competitive selection, decisions are made bases on the ABILITY AND ATTITUDE the athlete has displayed during the tryout.

## Athletic Team Selection Policy

1. Due to the competitiveness of the athletic league (CALOC) in which we participate, students in grades 5-8 can expect that the team will be cut to a workable number of players based upon ability, attitude and coachability.
2. Attendance at practice, compliance with team rules, ability, attitude and coachability will be factors which the coach will use to determine playing time and positions.
3. Playing time may not be equal and will be at the discretion of the coach.
4. Positions of the players on the team will also be at the discretion of the coach.

## Team Uniforms

All team uniforms are the property of CCS. Students/athletes are responsible for washing and returning their uniforms at the completion of each season. **If a student/athlete loses a uniform, he or she will be billed a \$75.00 replacement fee.**

As a member on a CCS athletic team, I realize that it is a privilege to participate in all athletic activities. Accordingly, I accept and will abide by the following **Athletic Contract:**

1. I will work DAILY during the season to improve my skills and to be an asset to my team.
2. I will play and practice with determination, energy, hustle and personal responsibility.
3. I will follow the rules, regulations and procedures specified by the school and the coach.
4. When the coach speaks, I will be respectful and listen. I will DO MY BEST to implement what the coach is asking me to do.
5. During practices and games, I will conduct myself in such a manner as to bring HONOR TO OUR LORD, SHOW RESPECT TO MY TEAM, OPPONENTS, OFFICIALS AND MY SCHOOL. I understand that if I do not act responsibly, that I might face consequences such as being asked to leave practice or being suspended for a game.
6. I understand that my **participation is a season long commitment** to my team, my coach and my school. I understand the time commitment required and that I am expected to be at all practices and games. I realize that if for some very important reason(s) I cannot attend a practice or a game, I will talk to my coach AT LEAST a day in advance. In addition, I realize that this may affect my playing time.
7. I will organize my time so that my academic responsibilities and outside activities do not conflict with practices or games. I understand that my team commitment does not excuse me from maintaining academic excellence (GPA of 2.0 and above).
8. I understand that it is the coach's sole responsibility to decide who will play in a game, match or contest and the amount of time to be played. I understand that playing time may not be equal.
9. I will support my teammates in a positive manner both on and off the court/field during practices and games.
10. I understand that I WILL BE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER CLOTHING AND ATHLETIC SHOES for each sport I play during all practices and games.
11. I will be personally responsible for all CCS equipment and uniforms given to me and will return it in good (washed) condition at the end of each season. I will be responsible for paying a \$75.00 replacement fee for any lost or damaged uniforms and/or equipment.
