

Good Morning AP Students and Parents,

Yesterday morning we received word from College Board that they are making adjustments to the 2020 AP Exam administration due to COVID-19 school closures. At this time, College Board has advised the following:

- For the 2019-2020 exam administration only, there will be no face-to-face exam administrations. Students may choose to take a 45-minute **online exam at home, or have their registration fees refunded.**
- Students will be able to take these streamlined exams **on any device**—computer, tablet, or smartphone. Taking a photo of handwritten work is also an option.
- We recognize that the digital divide could prevent some students from participating. **College Board is working to provide the tools and connectivity students need** to review AP content online and take the exam. Please click on the following link to inform College Board if any difficulty exists.
