The meeting opened by reviewing minutes from the previous meeting dated March 21, 2018. A motion was made by Renee Paterson to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded by Cheryl Burton. The vote was a counted vote with 6 in favor and 0 opposed. The motion passed.

- **Gibson Staffing**
Members reviewed recent staffing changes/vacancies at Gibson Middle School. Principal Jaeger presented information on positions currently available for surplus: VI SPTA (support staff) and 7th Grade ELA (Licensed Staff). Principal Jaeger also presented information on potential future vacancies in math and science.
- **School Initiatives and Planning**
