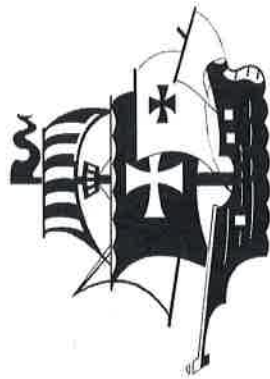

## Services Provided

## Become University Bound by Completing the A-G Requirements

In order to be eligible to apply to a University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU), students need to complete their A-G course requirements. Students need to complete all of these courses with a letter grade of "C" or better to be eligible. G	College Prep	1 Year
