Parent / Guardians,

Homecoming week is here and we are excited to welcome in this year's theme (Somewhere Beneath the Sea) filled with exciting events and activities. Homecoming is a time for students to share in their school pride through selected grade level competitions, a crowning of a King and Queen, followed by the Football Game and Homecoming Dance on Saturday. Students will celebrate with themed dress up days throughout the week along with several other in building events such as an Open Mic night on Tuesday September 18th 6:30 pm, Movie on the Lawn on Wednesday September 19th at 7:30 pm, and an Activity Fair before school and during all lunch periods in the Atrium on Thursday September 20th. As we draw closer to the dance and football game, we wanted to communicate building procedures for students and guests, as well as review handbook and safety expectations to ensure students, parents, and the community have an enjoyable Homecoming experience.

Upon arrival to the Kennelly Athletic Complex we are asking our guests to:

- Refrain from bringing outside food and beverages into the stadium.
- Students are not allowed to bring any type of bags into the game.
- There is no re-entry into the stadium for students.
- If a student has purchased a 2018-19 Activity Fee Pass, students will be allowed entry with their current school ID. Students who fail to bring their ID will pay full admission price at the gate. (\$3.00 for students, \$5.00 for adults, and \$2.00 Seniors)
- Students who are dropped off at the stadium should utilize the drop off area which is near the south gate on Ridgewood Rd. (Before Hollywood School.)

Homecoming week and dance reminders:

- Tickets for the Homecoming Dance can be purchased for \$10.00 each at the Door.
- The Homecoming Dance will be held in the Field House.
- A coat and bag check will be available.
- High heels will not be allowed at the dance.
- Dance guest permission forms should be turned in 5 days prior to the Homecoming Dance to the Assistant Principal of Student Affairs in the Main Office.
- Students will need to show their ID for entry into the Homecoming Dance.
- There will be no admittance to the Homecoming Dance for students who arrive after 7:30 pm.
- The Dance will begin promptly at 7:00 pm and will end at 10:00 pm.
- **Students are asked to refrain from celebratory activities i.e. (toilet papering, spray painting, damage to school property) Witnessed celebratory activities will result in disciplinary consequences: please refer to the student handbook page 34 item 21**
- Students are expected to adhere to all school rules at the dance: please refer to page 32 in the student handbook.
- Students are not allowed re-entry into the dance: please refer to the student handbook page 32.
- It is understood by all students to follow the rules, codes of conduct, policies and procedure: please refer to the code of conduct below and pages 8-9 of student handbook.
