

Frontier Academy Elementary Dress Code

Parents and students alike are responsible to adhere to the dress code. All clothes must have neat, clean appearance. Teachers will be checking students' dress each morning. Infractions will be noted and parents will be notified. On the third infraction, the parent will be asked to deliver the proper clothing to school. On the fourth infraction, the student may be sent home to change clothes. The student will not be allowed in class until they are in the proper dress code. Parents and students are expected to follow the spirit of the dress code and not try to find "loopholes".

Shorts, Pants, Skirts and Skorts:

- A. Colors: solid navy and khaki
- B. Fabrics: cotton twill, stiff polyester or corduroy
- C. Length: shorts may be no more than 3 inches above the knee. Pants should not drag on the ground
- D. Belts are optional

Dresses:

- A. Colors: solid navy, red, khaki, or white
- B. Fabrics: cotton twill, stiff polyester or corduroy
- C. Must have a collar
- D. May be no more than 3 inches above the knee
- E. Jumpers must be worn over a dress-code compliant shirt

Biker Shorts Leggings and Tights:

- A. Colors: solid navy, red, khaki, black or white
- B. Must not show below the hem of skirt, dress, or jumper
- C. Must be worn under skirts, dresses and jumpers

Shirts:

- A. Colors: Solid collared shirt in navy, red and white
- B. Shirts need to be long enough to stay tucked in at all times but no longer than the tips of the fingers when arms are relaxed at the sides
- C. No logos larger than a credit card

Sweaters and Sweater Vest:

- A. Colors: solid navy, red, or white
- B. Must be worn over a dress code-compliant shirt
- C. No logos larger than a credit card

Sweatshirts and Hoodies:

- A. Colors: solid navy, red or white
- B. No logos larger than a credit card
- C. Frontier Academy sweatshirts and hoodies are always allowed

Please note: Clothes should be properly fitted and worn as intended (not inside out) If any over garment is worn for warmth it must have a collared shirt underneath if the student will be taking it off during the day.

Shoes:

- A. All shoes must be closed-toed
- B. No blinking lights
- C. Heels may be no higher than 1” heels. No platform shoes
- D. Crocs are not allowed
- E. Heelys are not allowed
- F. Any color or design may be worn, but should not cause a classroom distraction
- G. Socks must be worn with shoes

Additional Guidelines:

Ear piercing:

- A. No more than 2 piercings per ear; small posts and small hoops up to 1 ½” may be worn. (No long dangling earrings.)

Eyes:

- A. Eyes must be seen

Outerwear (jackets, coats, hats and scarves):

- A. May not be worn inside
- B. Should be marked with student’s name

Items not allowed:

- A. Glitter on face, body or hair, visible tattoos, either real or stick-on
- B. Bandanas or hairnets
- C. Excessive hair color or hairstyles that cause a classroom distraction
- D. Scarves and hats are not to be worn indoors

Frontier Academy maintains a clothing bank for all families. Please contact a school staff member for directions. The clothing bank gladly accepts donations of quality new and used dress code clothing. Please bring donations to the elementary school.

Dress Down Day Guidelines:

Occasionally we will announce a dress down day for our students. The following is the guidelines for those days.

- A. Clothing must be fitted
- B. No holes in clothing
- C. Shorts and skirts must still be no higher than 3 inches above the knee
- D. No reference to drugs, alcohol, gangs, violence, or sex on any clothing
- E. Mid sections (stomachs) must be covered
- F. No tank tops or spaghetti strapped tops, no undergarment straps showing
- G. No open toed shoes or crocs may be worn

Spirit Wear:

On the last day of each week, students will be allowed to wear Frontier Academy Spirit Wear shirts. These shirts can be purchased through the Wolverine Booster Club, from Frontier Academy sponsored events or through our online store. This is not a dress down day. All other dress code policies apply.
