



DYE Second Grade Supply List

Below is a list of the supplies your child will need when he or she comes to second grade.

TO BRING TO SCHOOL EACH DAY:

- A backpack or bookbag without wheels with child's FULL NAME somewhere on or in the backpack
- A healthy snack and water bottle (if desired) labeled with child's name
- Weather-appropriate outer wear for outside recess

TO KEEP AT SCHOOL OR IN DESK:

Please put names on all supplies.

- ONE box of tissue
- At least 24 sharpened pencils with erasers
- TWO bar erasers and/or a package of individual pencil-top erasers
- TWO boxes of 24-count crayons
- FOUR highlighters (any color)
- FOUR odorless dry-erase markers
- ONE pair of scissors with rounded- or blunt-tips
- ONE bottle of white school glue
- TWELVE (or more) glue sticks (Every child uses about 1 a month!)
- ONE small plastic school box (approximately 5 x 8 inches; anything larger will not fit easily into student desks, anything smaller will not hold all of their supplies)
- ONE one-inch three-ring binder with hard sides
- FOUR folders with pockets and prongs
- FOUR composition notebooks
- Earbuds (Each child will need their own. We will be using our classroom laptops.)

OPTIONAL WISH LIST ITEMS TO DONATE TO CLASSROOM:

We use these items daily. If you would like to donate one or more of these items, they would be greatly appreciated. ☺

- Any items found on the supply list (We can always use extras for when we run out or when a new student arrives.)
- Containers of baby wipes or Clorox or Lysol wipes
- Lysol spray
- Hand-sanitizer
- Liquid soap
- Boxes of plastic baggies (snack, sandwich, quart, or gallon size)
- Boxes of band-aids
- Packs of clear sheet protectors (made to go in a three-ring binder)
- Black and color ink printer cartridges (See teacher for cartridge numbers)
(Ink is the most needed wish list item.)
- Post-it notes (any size)
- Address labels (any size but the 2" x 4" labels are especially needed)
- Heavy-duty Swingline brand staplers
- Three-hole paper punches
- White or colored cardstock (8.5" x 11") or packs of construction paper
- White socks to use as erasers for dry-erase boards

TO KEEP AT HOME FOR HOMEWORK/PROJECT USE:

- Sharpened pencils with erasers
- Glue (any type) and scissors
- Crayons and markers
- Plain white paper, colored paper, lined paper
- Basic addition and subtraction flash cards
