What is the purpose of the school report?

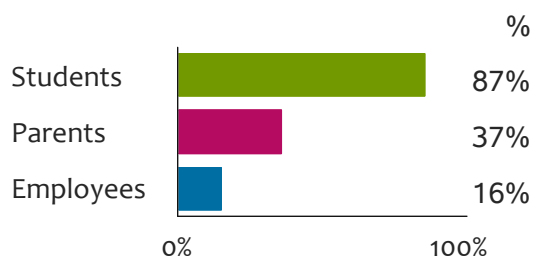
The purpose of this report is to provide detailed information on the responses that LAUSD students, parents and employees gave to the School Experience Survey last spring. The report gives schools feedback from the entire school community to inform their planning efforts.

Who is given an opportunity to participate in the School Experience Survey?

All school employees and students in grades 3-12 from regular LAUSD schools were asked to complete the survey. The majority of parents of elementary students, as well a sample of parents in middle and high schools, were also asked to participate, either by completing a survey sent home with their student or in the mail.

Students, parents, and school employees will be given a second opportunity to participate in the School Experience Survey in February 2010.

94%	were involved in their school
