Holiday Harp Concert—All Ages—Linda-Rose Hembreiker and Elaine Litster perform duet holiday classics on beautiful harps.

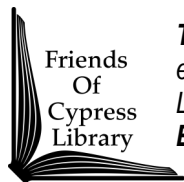
Veteran Care Kit Packaging—Adults/teens—Help a needy service member by assembling care packages with Oxford Academy.
