Valentine's parties will be on Friday, February 15th.



Kelso's Choice Conflict Management

This week at Llano Elementary we will introduce Kelso's Choice, our conflict management curriculum. Students will learn positive ways to deal with minor conflicts including:


1. Go to another game or activity.
2. Respectfully talk it over and listen to each other.
3. Walk away from the problem.
4. Ignore the problem behavior.
5. Tell the person to stop the problem behavior.
6. Apologize.
7. Make a deal or compromise.
8. Wait to cool off.
9. Share and take turns.
