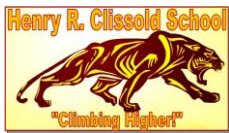

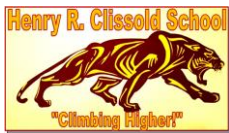

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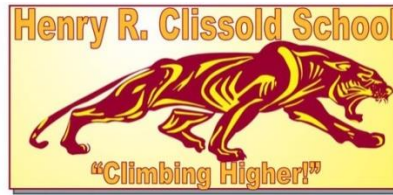
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Alice in Wonderland Jr Production Information

Welcome to Clissold Drama sponsored by Friends of Clissold. Perhaps you are a longtime supporter and performer, perhaps this is your first production with us. Whatever the case may be, we are so happy circumstances have led you here. Aside from your talent, there are several other components that you can help with that will make this production a huge success!

AUDITIONS: Auditions will be held Wednesday, January 9th and Thursday, January 10th from 3:00-5:00. Your child only needs to attend ONE of these dates. The callback list will be posted on Friday, January 11th and callbacks will be held on Monday, January 14th. Only those on the callback list should attend callbacks. The final cast list will be posted on Tuesday, January 15th and the first all cast rehearsal will be on Wednesday, January 16th.

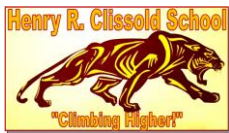
PRODUCTION FEES: Clissold Drama and FOC are nonprofit theater groups that provide amazing live productions at an affordable price. A big key to our success has been the quality of the shows we produce. We are requiring each cast member to contribute a production fee of \$20.00. This fee will cover the cost of some costuming, production, and will contribute to making this show a hit. ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BY MONDAY January 21. Payments can be made by Cash or Check. All checks can be made out to Friends of Clissold.

REHEARSAL ATTENDANCE: Rehearsals will be held on Mondays and Wednesdays from 3:00-4:30. Your child will only need to attend the rehearsals for which he or she is scheduled. You will receive a rehearsal schedule on a monthly basis. If your child has other commitments on Mondays and Wednesdays after school, this may not be the year to audition.

Any absences must have a note or email from the parent. If your child misses too many rehearsals, he or she may be asked to leave the show. Also, please take note of the behavior expectations. If your child has too many behavior infractions he or she will be asked to leave the show.

The week of the show, April 29, 30, May 1, 2, mandatory rehearsal will be every day from 3:00-5:30. The show is Friday, May 3 & Saturday, May 4. If you must miss any rehearsal or show between April 29-May 4, please do not audition.

CAST SHIRTS

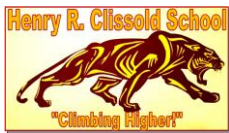
We are currently working on a design for cast shirts. As soon as we have some set prices and design, we will distribute an order form. All shirts will be distributed during tech week.

Clissold Drama is a long running and beloved tradition in the Clissold community. We build community and help each other grow in theatrical character. As part of this theatrical community, I commit myself to the following behavioral norms:

1. Clissold Drama will strive to be impartial and follow due process in its decision-making. I will accept the decisions made and present any concerns in a manner that facilitates resolution. I will not attempt to unfairly influence decision-making or undermine decisions made.
2. I will remember that Clissold Drama's purpose is to build character and community. I will not listen to or spread malicious gossip. I will not spread rumors that undermine community trust or other people's self-esteem.
3. I will not use language, discuss topics and/or act in ways that are offensive to others or incompatible with Clissold Drama's purpose.
4. I will keep my commitments including rehearsals and meetings, help other people keep their commitments, and let others know when I cannot keep mine.
5. I will help with set-up, clean-up and other work I can do during the production. This includes rehearsals, construction, tech week, and strike days.
6. I will seek ways to encourage and nurture others.
7. I will attempt to resolve conflicts personally and privately. If I cannot, I will bring them to the appropriate production leadership.
8. I will keep my written communication professional and limited to facts.

The production is the activity; we are here to enrich each other's lives and bond in friendship.
