PBIS Overview

PBIS stands for Positive Behavior Intervention & Support. PBIS is a school-wide program to teach **respect, responsibility, and safety** at school. PBIS is a recognized program used nationwide to help schools create positive culture in schools. PBIS is shown to increase instructional time, increase positive behavior and decrease disruptive behaviors school-wide.

- ◆ PBIS creates consistent expectations throughout our building
- ◆ Create a safe learning environment, both physically and emotionally
- ◆ Use data to make decisions
- ◆ Improves interactions between staff and students, staff and staff and student and students
- ◆ Model positive interactions for students
- ◆ Create opportunities for staff and students to celebrate success!

Raider Pride Cards

All staff members can issue Raider Pride Cards to students when they demonstrate expectations.

Fun Fridays

All students can participate in Fun Fridays. Students can earn RPC's for showing their school spirit!

School Store

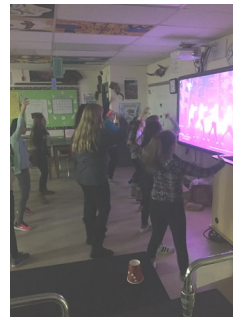
Every Friday morning, our student-run school store sells certificates for classroom privileges, fun items and school supplies.

Celebrations

At the end of each quarter, students use Raider Pride Cards to gain entry into the celebration. Students can also use RPC's to buy treats at the celebrations.

Instruction and Review
