Board Meeting Minutes

March 13, 2017

The Hoxie School Board met for their regular school board meeting on Monday, March 13, 2017, with all members present. President Dobbs called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Superintendent Baker recognized the 2017 Lady Mustangs 3A State Basketball Champions for playing hard all season and being good representatives of Hoxie School. The girls were present along with Coach Mike Chipman. Coach Chipman introduced each player and told the board, and those present, what each girl had to offer toward the team.
