



In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act (Subchapters D and E of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code), the Board may enter closed meeting to deliberate any subject authorized by Subchapter D that is listed on the agenda for this meeting.

TEXAS GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION:

- 551.071 Private consultation with the board's attorney
- 551.072 Discussing purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property
- 551.073 Discussing negotiated contracts for prospective gifts or donations.
- 551.074 Discussing personnel or to hear complaints against personnel
- 551.076 Considering the deployment, specific occasions for, or implementation of, security
- 551.082 Considering the discipline of a public school child, or complaint or charge against personnel
- 551.0821 Considering matters regarding a public school student if personally identifiable information about the student will necessarily be revealed
- 551.083 Considering the standards, guidelines, terms, or conditions the board will follow, or will instruct its representatives to follow, in consultation with representatives of employee groups.
- 551.84 Excluding witnesses from a hearing

Should any final action, final decision, or final vote be required in the opinion of the School Board with regard to any matter considered in such closed or executive meeting or session, then the final action, final decision, or final vote shall be either:

(a) in the open meeting covered by the Notice upon the reconvening of the public meeting, or:

(b) at a subsequent public meeting of the School Board upon notice thereof; as the school board determines
