

PSHS Grading Policy

1. Gradebooks are set up in the following manner:
 - a. 80% -- Summative Assessments (Summative tests, Papers, Major Assignments, etc.)
 - b. 20% -- Formative Assessments (quizzes, homework, etc.)
2. Quarter Grades
 - a. Gradebooks start over each quarter
 - b. Students will be required to pass each quarter to earn the credit
 - c. Final grades will be determined by averaging the 4 quarters together
 - d. Students will be required to pass (show competency) on each summative assessment to pass the quarter.
 - i. If a student does not pass all of the summative assessments, the grade will be reflected as incomplete (inc.) for that quarter.
 - e. Students have 1 week after each quarter to turn in missing work for that quarter and to complete retakes for work due within that quarter.
3. Retakes/Redos
 - a. Students will be allowed to retake or redo any summative assessment within the quarter per teacher's guidelines.
 - b. Students will receive a maximum score of 90% on any assignment which needs to be retaken or redone.
4. Late Work
 - a. Students will receive a maximum score of 90% on any summative assessment turned in after the due date. This includes failure to take a test on the designated date.
5. Midterms and Finals
 - a. These assessments will be part of the "Summative Assessment" grade.
 - i. Though they are factored into the final grade, students are not required to pass them to get credit like all other summative assessments.
 - b. Retakes and Redos on Midterms and Finals are at the teacher's discretion.
6. Summer School
 - a. Summer school is offered to students who fail a core class (Math, English, Science, and Social Studies)
 - b. In summer school, students will work to pass any failed summative assessments.
 - i. Credit will be given once all summative assessments are passed.
