## Lincoln Junior High Career Day helps students explore options

Lincoln Junior High Counselor Aimie Patrick designed a Career Day experience this year to help students make the connection between what they are learning in the classroom and their futures.

Students attended 12 separate sessions, with guest speakers who represented a variety of professions.

“The sessions are based on the 16 career clusters they can explore in high school, college, or trade school,” said Patrick.

The first half of the day, students took notes from each session, in a provided booklet. The second half

of the day, students discussed their findings in their regular classrooms.

“We want to help students figure out how to take that next step,” said Patrick. “If they wait until they are freshman to start to focus on college and career readiness and what comes next, it’s too late.”
