Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

Starting Monday, May 7, 2018, there will be a new way to make payments for your child's meals. The Hawaii State Department of Education (HIDOE) has contracted with *Harris Solutions* to modernize our meal payment and monitoring. You now can check your child's school meal account balance online, as well as make payments with your Visa, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express credit or debit card.

In addition to helping the school take advantage of the latest technology, this service is a great convenience to you. By utilizing www.EZSchoolPay.com, you will not have to wonder if the check you wrote for meals actually made it to school and your children will be assured that meals will continue uninterrupted.

Features and Options:

- Send payments faster and directly into your child's meal accounts (payments are credited within 10 minutes);
- Mobile Applications: EZSchoolPay is available from your device's app store and is available for iPhone, iPad, and Android devices. Receive alerts of low balances, make payments for your child's meal account, and purchase items from the school store; and
- Low Balances: Receive alerts when your child's balance drops below a certain balance.

If you would like to take advantage of any of the features mentioned above, you must create an online account with www.EZSchoolPay.com with your *child's last name and his/her student number, which is located under their name on their report card*. Getting started is easy! Visit www.EZSchoolPay.com. The website will guide you to create an account and link your student(s) to the account before entering a credit/payment.

Walk-in payments will still be accepted at school's front office; however, payments must be deposited in the drop box on the front office counter by 10:45 a.m. in order for the funds to be available to purchase lunch(es) on the same day. As of May 14, 2018, personal checks will NOT be accepted as payment for meals, which will enable us to provide cash refunds to parents/students for balances remaining at the end of the school year.
