## MUSIC MUST BE SUBMITTED TO ME VIA EMAIL BY FRIDAY, FEBRUARY 22nd.

- If your child's music contains lyrics and is not the instrumental/karaoke version you **MUST** resubmit the music. The guidelines state that your child cannot sing over someone else. If music/sound effects are not submitted by Friday, February 22nd, your child will NOT perform. They must be emailed to [jenydiperna@gmail.com](mailto:jenydiperna@gmail.com). There are further instructions on how to submit when you fill out the registration form.

**The file name must be your child's first name, last name and the song title (for instrumental acts also). Follow this exact format: ex. Jennifer DiPerna-The Fight Song**

If your child is the least bit apprehensive please let us know ASAP before we print the program. All performers will receive a certificate of participation after they perform.

## Talent Show Guidelines:

- All acts must be elementary school appropriate, including appropriate song lyrics.
- Any number of students can perform in an act.
- Acts must look well-rehearsed, entertaining, and be **under three minutes**.
- Impromptu acts will not be performed in the Talent Show - students must make sure to take practice and planning seriously.
- Students who wish to sing songs must have instrumental accompaniment **without** the lead vocal component (pre-recorded or live) to help them stay on pitch.
- Students are required to bring in all props, accompaniment music, sheet music, instruments, etc.. necessary for their act. We do have a piano for use.
- Auditions are necessary to allow students to experience time on the stage and as a "practice" so use it accordingly.
