WHAT WE HAVE BEEN DOING



Installed **lock blocks on all doors** to close and lock quickly in the event of an emergency.



Installed **window shades** for windows on classroom doors.



Installed **window film** for added safety and privacy.



Repaired fence lines district-wide and added multiple emergency egress (self-closing) gates to allow for rapid evacuation, if needed.



Provided **uniform work clothing** for maintenance, custodial and support staff.



Hired two School Resource Officers to be primarily located at each comprehensive high school.



Deploying a **new Visitor Management System**. All adults on campus will need an ID badge.



Deploying an **enhanced emergency communications system** throughout the District. Once completed new digital radios and signal repeaters will allow for District-wide emergency communications for all sites.
