Composition of SDGVA Governance Board:

The number of members in the SDGVA Governance Board shall be at least five (5) but no more than seven (7). SDGVA will include at least one (1) parent or legal guardian of SDGVA students. It is SDGVA's goal to create a diverse board with representation in the areas of education, business, legal and/or fiscal management. Experience in the charter community is preferred but not required. We provide training for SDGVA Governance Board members.
