Apply for Free or Reduced Meals Online!

You can use your smart phone, tablet, computer, or any device that connects to the internet! Sign into family.titank12.com and create an account. Once you are signed into Titan School Solutions you can make a payment on your student's account, view your student's meal activity and apply for Free & Reduced Meals.

Qualifying for Free or Reduced Priced Meals can save you \$405 per year for a TK-8 student and \$540 for a student in 9-12 grade.
