Did you know that on March 4, 1789 the Constitution was put into effect even though it was created September 17, 1787? It has been in effect since March 4, 1789. It took almost two years for nine of the thirteen states to approve the Constitution. The U.S. Constitution gives us many rights including the basic right to vote. It also ensures that our government is ruling the people as the founding fathers intended.

Some other main points in the Constitution are limited government, republicanism, checks and balances, federalism, separation of powers, and popular sovereignty. The Constitution is also called a "living document" because of how it is changed and grows over time as new laws and amendments are added. An example of the of the Constitution changing was when after World War 1, the 18th Amendment banned the consumption and production of alcohol. This was later changed by the 21st Amendment, which reversed the ban. The Constitution helps the people by protecting their basic rights, and preventing the government from having too much power.
