


PSAT, SAT & ACT STUDY HALL

We meet on Mondays, from 3 p.m. to 5 p.m., in room C-107. If Monday is a holiday, then we meet on Wednesday of that week.


What Materials to Bring

Because these books contain actual copies of past SAT or ACT test, as well as detailed explanation for each problem, they are excellent resource for test preparation. (The SAT and PSAT test questions are very similar, so by using the SAT Study Guide, students are indirectly studying for the PSAT as well.)

If students are planning to take the PSAT in October and they have a copy of the PSAT Practice Test, then they can bring it to the Study Hall. Mr. Yi can email the document that contains detailed explanation. Students should still get hold of one or both books mentioned above.

What Do Students Do During Study Hall?

During study hall, students can work out the problems from either book, check their answers, and read detailed explanations as needed. If some explanations are unclear, or students would like different/additional explanation, then they can ask Mr. Yi for help. (Mr. Yi has worked out every problem in these books.)

Alternatively, students can work out these problems at home and bring questions to our weekly session.

When students have completed all the problems from these books, Mr. Yi can give them *additional copies* of past tests, including two sets of PSAT test.
