



## **Raptor Access Requirements and Approved Activities for Visitors and Volunteers**

During normal school hours all campus visitors must present a photo ID and obtain a “Visitor” badge from Raptor\*.

Raptor\* entries are **NOT** required for visitors who are entering the campus (**regardless of time**) for the purpose of a scheduled: special school event/activity; school sponsored performance by a class, team, club or group; or open house.

During normal school hours all volunteers must present a photo ID and obtain a “Volunteer” badge from Raptor\*.

Raptor\* entries **ARE** required for volunteers who are entering the campus (**regardless of time**) for the purpose of assisting or participating in a scheduled: special school event/activity; school sponsored performance by a class, team, club or group; or open house.

### **VISITORS are entitled to:**

- Eat lunch with their child
- Parent - Teacher conferences
- Student Academic/Instructional related conferences
- Administrative related meetings/activities
- Discipline conferences
- Observe their child’s class
- Visit with their child on “Field Day”

### **VOLUNTEERS are entitled to:**

- Chaperone approved field trips and other school sanctioned trips
- Volunteer, assist or serve on campus
- Assist teachers in the classroom
- Join their child on field trips (no chaperone or volunteer duties)
- Host, sponsor or assist with student clubs or other sanctioned activities
- Assist/Participate in extra-curricular activities and events, school programs and seasonal parties
- All Raptor accessible activities

***\*Raptor conducts a quick scan of photo ID entries. Any non-approval or “hit” by Raptor must be reported to Campus Administrators immediately.***

***The Campus maintains an approved Volunteer Listing. Only persons on the approved list may assist, participate and/or serve the school and its students.***

***All Accessible Activities and/or Volunteer Duties shall be at the discretion and direction of Campus Administrators.***
