<p><u>TOPS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collared shirts • Maspeth Team and Club Gear tops • Polos • Buttoned Down Shirts with collars • Dresses (ID card length from your knee) • Sweaters IF there is a collared shirt showing underneath • Turtlenecks <p><u>BOTTOMS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Khakis • Corduroys • Dress pants • Slacks • Skirts (ID card length from your knee) • All pants should have zippers, buttons and pockets 	<p><u>TOPS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shirts without a collar • T-shirts • Henley Shirts • Tank tops • Cowl Necks • Non-Maspeth Sweatshirts or hoodies • Crop tops • Halter Tops • Spaghetti Straps • Hats or other head coverings, including scarves, headbands, sweatbands, hoods, do-rags, hair picks, and bandanas, may not be worn, except for religious purposes. • Midriff • No t-shirt on top of collared shirts • Tube tops • No underwear, undershirts, bras, or bra straps may be visible under any circumstance. • No shoulders, stomachs, or plunging neck lines may be visible under any circumstance. • Collared jackets DO NOT replace collared shirts • No jackets with a hood • No sunglasses <p><u>BOTTOMS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Jeans • Maspeth Gear Bottoms • Shorts • Capris • Tights • Joggers • Denim • Any pants with a rivet • NO OPEN-TOED shoes • No slippers <p><u>MISC</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No graphics over two inches • Clothing should not contain offensive words or phrases • No visible electronics
