Dear St. Elizabeth Families,

Now that the weather has turned colder and will stay cold, I remind you to have your children wear a coat to school every day. The students will be going out for recess as long as the temperatures are above freezing. Fresh air and the ability to run around and play is good for them.

This year the HSA has a contract with No Fuss Lunch to provide students with the option of a hot lunch three days per week. I am told that the orders for lunch are well below the expected and historical numbers. I realize our enrollment is a little lower, but the lunch order count is down to an average of 35-40 lunches per day. Due to this downturn, it may be necessary for us to terminate our relationship with No Fuss Lunch. This means we would only serve lunch two days per week and the children will have to bring lunch the other days. I know this is an inconvenience and HSA may explore other options, but the daily counts would have to increase to contract with any vendor. Right now, snacks are up in the air on those days as well. HSA may send out a quick survey next week to get your feedback. I will keep you informed.

I hope you are getting in shape for the 5K Race on 12/7. I hope to see you and your children there.
