Battle of the Classes will be held Friday March 22nd, 2019.

Day of the Week	Theme	Description
Monday 3/18/2019	Patriotic Day	Students may wear any form of red, white and blue attire that positively represents America. Graphic t-shirts must be appropriate. Please avoid contentious political gear. You may wear jeans, leggings, UGGs and sneakers. Masks are not permitted.
Tuesday 3/19/2019	Decade Day	Seniors 80's Freshman 90's Juniors 70's Sophomores 50's
Wednesday 3/20/2019	Pajama Day (\$5 participation fee, collection during HR's)	Students may wear their favorite PJs. Pajamas must be worn: not questionable casual attire that can be passed off as pajamas (i.e. t-shirts). You may wear sneakers, UGG boots & slippers but they must have a back, no slip-ons. No jeans or leggings.
Thursday 3/21/2019	Jersey Day	Support your favorite sports team with a jersey/t-shirt/uniform. Bottoms may be jeans, sweatpants or leggings. No hats/helmets.
Friday 3/22/2019	School Spirit Day	The student body and faculty will wear the annual Battle of the Classes t-shirts (given out in the morning while decorating the gym) and any Dom's bottoms. You may wear your uniform shoes or UGGs but if you are participating in Battle of the Classes, you MUST wear sneakers. No leggings or jeans permitted.

Please note that if students choose not to participate in spirit wear, they **must** be in full uniform. Regular, casual street clothes are not permitted on any day in lieu of the themed dress-up attire.

Please remember that "spirit" is a major part of the judging for Battle of the Classes. The more students dressed up in each grade, and the better their spirit attire is, the better your class will do in these areas of the competition!
