

ACADEMIC STATISTICS (Class of 2018) – 105 graduates

College Enrollment

- The class of 2018 was accepted to 103 colleges and universities and will attend 51 different post- secondary institutions.
- 91% of graduates matriculating continued their education at a 4 year college or university
- 9 % of graduates matriculating continued their education at a 2 year community or technical college
- 65% matriculating to college remained in Georgia
- 35% matriculating to college went out of state

Scholarships

Members of the class of 2018 were offered \$7,488,680 in grants, academic and athletic scholarships.

College Entrance Exams

SAT

- The top 10% = 1361 (out of 1600)
- The top 25% = 1277 (out of 1600)
- The top 50% = 1201 (out of 1600)
- Average score = 1080
 - EBRW= 544
 - Math = 536

ACT

- The top 10% = 33
- The top 25% = 30
- The top 50% = 26
- Average composite = 25

AP RESULTS

- Students took 254 exams in 14 subjects
- AP Scholars- 17
- AP Scholar with Distinction- 5
